## 7. Old Business:

A. Veteran's Park Picnic Table – The proposed two round picnic tables with umbrellas would be on a concrete pad 17' wide and 8' deep along the side of the caboose at Veteran's Park. Pearson made a motion to allow concrete to be installed and two round tables with umbrellas to be put in place, seconded by Sherry. Ayes: Pearson and Sherry, Nays: Thorngren. Motion passed 2-1

- B. Friends of Lowell Park Ana Kautza presented a proposal to improve Lowell Park divided into phases highlighting the goals of the group and ideas/plans to reach those goals over the next few years. Examples of improvements: Shelter roof replacement, play equipment, benches, gazebo replacement and updates to the walking trail. Sherry made a motion to approve Phase 1 of the project replacing the shelter roof, removing stumps and trees that are dead, seconded by Pearson. All ayes. The Park Dept. has up to \$1,200 available for roof material if needed.
- C. lowa Wild Community ice rink liner application Thorngren said the application was submitted last month and heard back on July 14<sup>th</sup> the City of Boone was selected as a recipient of a new ice rink liner. Thorngren made a motion to allow her to create a committee including volunteers to be involved in brainstorming for ice rink events and fulfilling the requirements of the program, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.

## 8. New Business:

- A. Memorial Park Baseball project Kevin Houston represents the Boone Baseball Club (all volunteers) that operates Memorial Field including concessions and upkeep. They have installed new fencing, batting cages and improved drainage. Houston reported their next project is updating lights. Memorial Park is one of the nicest fields in the area and the board thanked the Boone Baseball Club for all of their dedication and hard work.
- B. Pickleball Clinic at Memorial Park Pickleball Courts Nate Osmundson would like to hold a pickleball clinic at the Memorial Park pickleball courts. Sherry made a motion to allow the Boone Recreation Department to have pickleball clinics in August or September using the pickleball courts at Memorial Park with dates to be coordinated with Mike Cornelis, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.
  - C. Pufferbilly Days Art in the Park Jennifer Hanson
- 1. Wine Vendor There is a wine vendor that would like to participate in Pufferbilly Art in the Park. Hansen will provide volunteers to monitor the area. Pearson made a motion to allow the sale of wine slushies requiring the vendor to follow city and park requirements for alcohol sales, seconded by Thorngren. All ayes.
- 2. BBQ contest The contestants for the BBQ contest at McHose Park during Art in the Park need permission to be in the park after midnight to be able to prepare their entries for the contest. Motion by Thorngren to allow BBQ contestants to be in McHose park after closing the night before Art in the Park as long as they are present at all times during cooking, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.
- D. Boone Pool memorial bench and renaming the baby pool in honor of Elizabeth Boesen

  In a letter to the board, pool manager Darci Newcomb would like to place a recycled plastic bench on the pool deck with an inscription on it in memory of Elizabeth Boesen. She would also like to rename the baby pool "Itty Bitty Pool in memory of Elizabeth with a sign to honor her huge involvement in Boone aquatics. There will be no cost or labor since all money for both was donated. Sherry made a motion to approve a memorial bench on the pool deck and rename the baby pool "Itty Bitty Pool in memory of Elizabeth Boesen with exact locations of sign and bench to be approved by Cornelis, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.
- E. McHose tennis court resurfacing time frame Cornelis said the company has to reschedule resurfacing To sometime in August. Resurfacing needs to be done in hot, dry weather to cure. The ideal time would be the first two weeks of August since girls' tennis starts August 17<sup>th</sup>. Cornelis will let the High School Athletic Director know if there will be any delay that may affect home tennis meets.
- F. Permission to dispose of and old truck at the cemetery Cornelis said the old truck at the cemetery is no longer used and they don't need. Thorngren made a motion to dispose of the old truck previously used at the cemetery, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.
- **G.** McHose Park 100 year anniversary 2026 2027 Thorngren made a motion to form a committee to develop plans for McHose Park 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary, seconded by Pearson. All ayes.
- 9. Superintendent/Director's Report Cornelis is working on a plan for stumps in the parking. Bids will be collected to remove 350 stumps. Need more part-time help. Purchased a new pool cleaner. A donation was received to replace the roof at Larrew Park. Electrical panel update for softball lights should be done next week. Installing benches at two parks and the bike trail. Cornelis is working with ISU on the park survey that will be available in September or sooner.
- 10. <u>Commissioner's Report</u> Thorngren reported there will not be an Iowa Wild on Wheels event during RVTV. Thanks to Tim Modeland for repairing Mickey Mouse at Anderson Park and thanks to Elite for donating materials and labor for work at the Welcome to Boone sign.
