The City of Boone continues to work through the storm damage that occurred on August 10th, 2020. We are aware there are still citizens without power. As of the morning of August 13th, 2020 that number was around 800. The City Administrator has daily phone contact with a representative of Alliant.

If there is damage to any electrical items that are homeowner's responsibility, please call an electrician now because of potential backlogs. See City of Boone's website for further information.

Following above will help to limit the delay in receiving power because Alliant's crew will not complete the connection until they know it's safe for them and the customer ; and they don't want their customers to be without power any longer than they have to. Alliant contact number is 1800ALLIANT.

City crews have begun the cleanup process. Citizens are asked to place storm damaged trees and limbs on the parking for pickup. This cleanup will take several weeks to complete. All information will be placed on the City website at www.boonegov.com; as well as our facebook page.

The City Hall auditorium will be open as a cooling off venue for those who are without air conditioning. The hours this week will be til 3pm today and 8-5pm tomorrow Friday August 14th, 2020.
