The City of Boone will be conducting an income survey throughout the city to determine eligibility of the city to apply for grant funds for future wastewater system projects. Survey crews from an independent, private firm will be conducting the survey on the following weekends:

September 29-30

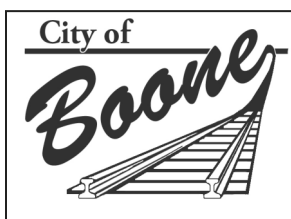
The survey crews will have identification name badges with a City of Boone logo for security. Grant funds would be able to help the City complete the projects needed, while limiting the impact on user rates.

The survey should take only a couple minutes per home and will be kept confidential and does not need to be signed. Information gathered by this survey will only be used for grant application purposes.

The city encourages residents contacted by the survey crew to assist with the process. It is critical that the City have this information for the application for funding.

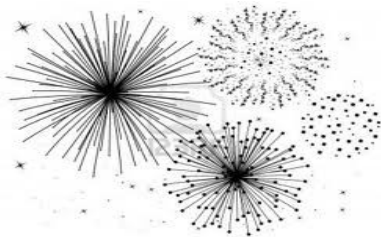
