

STATEMENT OF COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

December 4, 2018 6:00 p.m.
Goal Setting Work Session

The City Council of Boone, Iowa, met in special session at the Boone Police Department on December 4, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Slight presiding. The following Council Members were present: Byrd, Stines, Hicks, Pklapp, Stecker, and Ray. Absent: McGinn.

Hicks moved; Pklapp seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Ayes: Stines, Hicks, Pklapp, Stecker, Ray, and Byrd. Nays: none.

Skare updated the Council on the current year goal: 332 West 2nd Street property, 106 Webster Street property, street maintenance, Mary Garvey Fund Projects, and maintenance on the Water and Wastewater Plants infrastructure.

Hicks left the meeting at 6:08 p.m.

Elmqvist presented an overview of the 5 year budget.

Ray stated that he would like to see the City stay firm on a tax levy that is fair to all tax payers throughout the County in regards to the Communication Center.

Ray moved, Pklapp seconded to set the following as goals for Fiscal Year 2020: re-establishing a School Resource Officer, downtown revitalization, continue demolition and in-fill, and a marketing campaign.

Other ideas that were discussed included: Updating the skate park; this was determined to be a Park Board decision. Establishing a Business License Application, it was decided to put this on hold. Appoint a Public Arts Advisory Board, Mayor Slight requested Stecker to take the lead on this.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
