The winning bidder will be responsible for mowing properties that are not compliant with the City of Boone Municipal Code Chapter 151. These lawns will have weeds and grass growths of 12 inches and higher. The City may opt for a 1 (one) or 2 (two) year contract with the winning bidder.

Mowing Bid Specifications

The selected lawn services(s) will be mowing lawns that are in violation of the City of Boone Municipal Code 151, which have grass and weed growths in excess of 12 inches.

The lawn service will need to be able to mow lawns within 72 hours of receiving the address of the property in violation. Proof of liability insurance and ability to complete the project will be required after notification of award of the bid.

The lawn service will be required to handle all repairs to equipment, including but not limited to, flat tires, broken chains and or belts, and dull blades.

The lawn service will be contacted by the Community Service Officer when a lawn needs to be mowed. Note that some lawns will be mowed several times throughout the summer.

Not all homes that are in violation are vacant. If a resident approaches a representative of the lawn service while they are mowing the property, the representative is to direct the resident to contact the Community Service Officer for information. The lawn service representative is to be courteous, and if a confrontation begins, the representative is to leave the property and contact the Community Service Officer.

The lawn service is to be respectful of the property and neighbors, including noise and personal property issues. ***Do not blow grass clippings into the street***, as this is a violation of the Boone Municipal Code.

The lawn service will be responsible for mowing and trimming the property and either mulching the clippings so as to not leave piles, or removing the clippings and disposing of them properly.

The lawn service is required to turn in the provided bill from to the Community Services Officer, which will be submitted for payment to the City Council, and paid following the Council approval. Council meetings are held on the first and third Monday's of the month and bills must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the meeting date in order to be approved and then placed on the Council agenda.
